

**Open position at the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Surveying of the Technische Universität München from
1st of October 2011**

Chair of Land Management (W3)

The applicant must provide a proven record of having caused a broad impact onto the field of land management in urban as well as in rural areas at national (German) and international levels, demonstrate intercultural work experience and the capability of working in interdisciplinary environments. Key aspects of his/her practical and scientific work should include cadastral systems, land readjustment and consolidation, land use management, land-related development concepts and the associated planning theories and implementation methods, real estate and land valuation as well as the transfer of professional competence to developing and emerging countries.

The Chair of Land Management has comprehensive tasks in the pertinent academic teaching areas. Moreover, the direction of the international Postgraduate "Master's Programme Land Management and Land Tenure for Professionals" is among its key responsibilities.

In addition, the position holder will have responsibilities within the Institute of Geodesy, GIS and Land Management and the Centre for Land, Water and Environmental Risk Management. Research activities will be required by the University, above all, in close collaboration with the Centre of Life and Food Sciences Weihenstephan and the Faculty of Architecture, particularly in the fields of Agriculture and Forestry, Land Use, Town and Landscape Planning and Climate Research.

Applicants must hold a university degree in "Geodesy and Geoinformation" respectively "Surveying", pedagogic skills, doctoral and postdoctoral ("Habilitation") degrees or evidence of equally relevant scientific qualifications, which could also have been developed in the context of a Junior Professor's position or outside the university environment. A "Graduate Civil Servant" or "Assessor" Certificate (so called Second State examination) is desirable. Applicants must not be older than 52 years at the time of their appointment. An exception to the age limit can be admitted in special cases. Severely disabled candidates will be favoured in case their competences are basically the same as those of other candidates.

In the context of the Federal and State Excellence Initiative, the Technische Universität München has set itself the strategic goal of increasing the proportion of women participating in research and teaching. Therefore female scientists are strongly encouraged to submit applications.
